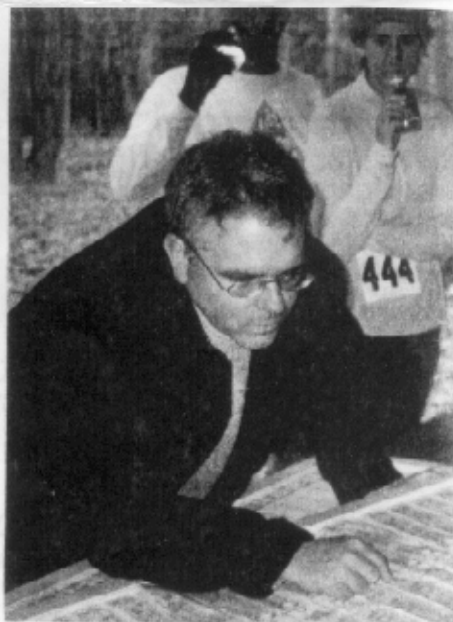

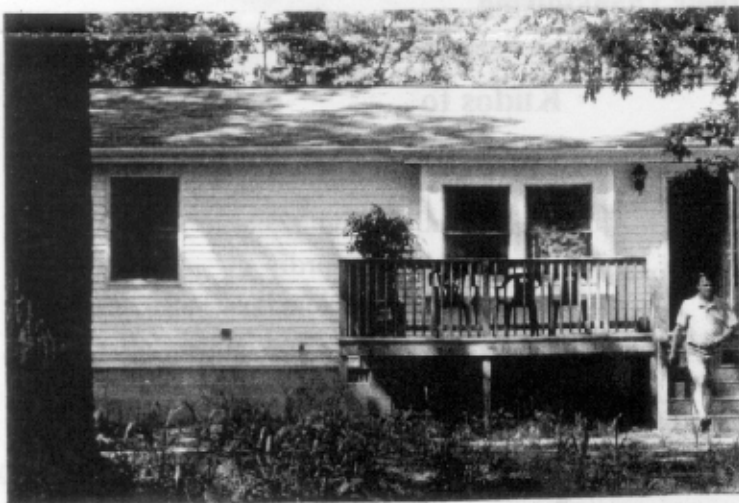


The raffle and door prizes were ex-
